

PARTNERSHIP WITH PARENTS POLICY

The school is committed to an active partnership with parents.

In order to achieve this:

- Appointments are offered at mutually agreed times
- Regular Newsletters are sent home to parents
- Home -School Agreements are published in the school journal.
- Letters are sent out to parents to inform them of PFA events, College events and any changes, and also posted on parentmail.
- All parents are invited to receive emails via parentmail.

There are regular opportunities for parents to meet more formally with staff. Formal parent-teacher consultations are organised for each year Group on an annual basis.

Parents are invited to PLP option interviews, year 10 information evening and post 16 information evening.

Progress checks are sent home once a term, and an annual full school report is issued.

The PFA organises termly social events to encourage parents to meet with members of the staff and other parents on an informal basis. Concerts and plays also provide a venue for contact between parents and staff.
